A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF PERRY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE 2007 UPDATE TO THE PERRY COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, PROVIDING FOR A PLAN FOR LAND USE, A PLAN TO MEET THE HOUSING NEEDS, A PLAN FOR THE MOVEMENT OF PEOPLE AND GOODS, A PLAN FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES AND UTILITIES, A PLAN FOR THE PROTECTION OF NATURAL AND HISTORIC RESOURCES, AND OTHER ASSOCIATED REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPALITIES PLANNING CODE (ACT OF 1968, P.L. 805, NO. 247. AS REENACTED AND AMENDED).

WHEREAS, the Perry County Perry Planning Commission has been enacted to serve in the official capacity as the planning agency for Perry County; and

WHEREAS, the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission continues to provide staffing support to the Perry County Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (Act of 1968, P.L. 805, No. 247. as reenacted and amended) empowers counties to adopt comprehensive plans; and

WHEREAS, the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission developed the Regional Growth Management Plan in 2003 to guide development in the Tri-County Region; and

WHEREAS, the Perry County Planning Commission has prepared a Final Draft of the 2007 Update to the Perry County Comprehensive Plan for the Perry County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Perry County benefited financially from a Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development Land Use Planning and Technical Assistance Grant to complete the Plan and perform outreach; and

WHEREAS, the Perry County Commissioners recognize the importance of coordinating planning consistency at the various levels of government; and

WHEREAS, the Plan intends to further the Tri-County Region's Plan as it pertains to growth management; and
