Task Description:

The Regional Connections program is intended to advance coordinated implementation of TCRPC's Regional Growth Management Plan (RGMP) and HATS' Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) and connect land use and transportation decisions being made at the local level.

Regional Connections is an opportunity for the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission (TCRPC) to support local development and redevelopment efforts in the individual counties and municipalities of the region while accomplishing planning objectives which reinforce the interrelated regional goals of the RGMP and RTP.

The Regional Connections program is designed to support the creation or execution of plans within and between municipalities that link land use and transportation to create a more sustainable region. Activities undertaken must emphasize context-sensitive, cost-effective solutions that serve to manage growth, enhance community character, and maximize existing infrastructure capacity. The Regional Connections program places priority on multi-municipal planning efforts necessary to provide for the orderly growth and development of the region.

TCRPC will continue to manage and implement a program to provide funding, on a competitive basis, to qualifying municipalities in the region. These municipalities will undertake locally-directed actions to improve their communities. TCRPC will coordinate application review, develop contracts and award funding based on completed work, and monitor project progress.

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The previous rounds of the Regional Connections program have successfully identified and funded a range of twenty-one (21) regional and local projects including form based code ordinance, official map and ordinance, trail and bicycle connections plans, bike share feasibility study, urban redevelopment plan, multi-modal corridor studies, sidewalk and traffic calming plan, downtown revitalization plans and design guidelines, and comprehensive plans.

For FY 2017 the Regional Connections program the scope will be limited to those projects that will enhance a municipality's connection to the region's transit systems. Examples of projects that will be considered include, but are not limited to, transit route expansion studies, Transit Oriented Development (TOD) code updates, and redevelopment plans that enhance access to transit stops. FY 2018 will include eligible projects for highway funds as well.
