- 49 total questions on SurveyMonkey




Zip Code Locations


The majority of survey participants live in the southern region of Dauphin County.

Age Demographics








Housing Type
















What is the most important role that Dauphin County should play in attracting, keeping, and growing businesses in the country?


Looking into the future and comparing it to the present, how much attention should be given to each of the following transportation goals?


What is the most important role that Dauphin County should play to make all forms of transportation better?






How do you think Dauphin County should use its resources to promote and conserve the natural, cultural, and agricultural resources?








